1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Potential, based on a weekly draw, to last 48 weeks.
2. Must be at least 18 years of age to play.
3. Any current member of the Kin Club of Russell Catch the Ace Committee (CAC), are not permitted to purchase tickets.
4. Any winner who is paid a prize agrees to grant to the Kin Club of Russell an irrevocable right to publish, through all types of media broadcasting, including the internet, for the purposes of promoting the win, their full name, hometown and photograph without any claim for broadcasting, printing or other rights. The winner who is paid a prize also gives to the Kin Club of Russell the right to publish any additional information that they voluntarily provide. The winner shall have no claim against the Kin Club of Russell for invasion of privacy or any other ground(s) by reason of the publication or broadcasting of their name, hometown or photograph or information voluntarily provided by the winner.
5. The winner will provide their full name, address and phone number to the Kin Club of Russell for reporting requirements to Russell Township. The address and phone number will NOT be made public.
6. Once the Ace of Spades is revealed, the game is concluded and Russell Township is notified immediately.
7. This raffle operates under the terms and conditions of Russell Township.

2. LOTTERY PROCEEDS

During the pilot project of Catch the Ace, the Kin Club of Russell will be submitting its application to Manage and Conduct a Raffle Lottery, with proceeds being used for projects listed in our current club budget (2016/17) including the Russell Reality Tour drug prevention/awareness program, youth sports equipment and donation(s) to Cystic Fibrosis Canada.

3. TICKET SALES

1. Must be at least 18 year of age to play.
2. Tickets are only valid for the draw date as printed on the ticket.
3. Tickets are \$5.00 each.
4. Tickets will be sold during the week of the draw by individual ticket sellers¹ and selected ticket outlets:
 - Foodland (Russell);
 - Pierre et Fils (Embrun); and
 - Pronto (Russell).

Ticket sales cease at 12:00 p.m. on the draw date by the individual ticket sellers and at the selected outlets. Tickets will be available for purchase each Sunday at the Russell Legion from 1:00 to 3:00 pm, with the draw occurring at 3:30 p.m.

¹ Individual ticket sellers must be members of the Kin Club of Russell.

5. The purchaser must:

- Ensure their ticket is filled out completely;
- Complete the ticket stub, including name, contact information and one (1) envelope number. *Enter a valid envelope number (1 to 52) from the list of available numbers on display at the sales location.*

4. DRAW TIME AND LOCATION

1. Sales will be held from 1:00p.m. until 3:00 p.m., followed by the draw at 3:30 pm on Sundays at the Royal Canadian Legion, Russell Branch #372 located at 24 Legion Lane in Russell, Ontario.²
2. Each Sunday one winning ticket will be drawn at random from that week's ticket sales by a CAC member
3. Only one (1) ticket will be drawn each week.³
4. Purchaser of the drawn ticket does not need to present at the draw location to win.
5. All draws are video recorded and posted on the Kin Club of Russell social media accounts (Website, Facebook and Twitter). Recording will show the name and envelope number on the winning ticket.

5. DRAW RULES

1. Draw Prize and Progressive Jackpots amounts will be announced prior to each draw.
2. At 3:30 p.m. one (1) ticket stub will be randomly drawn from all tickets sold that week, the envelope number shown on the ticket will be opened. Distribution of weekly ticket sales revenue is as follows:
 - 20% to the winning ticket holder;
 - 30% will be added to the jackpot;
 - 50% will go to the Kin Club of Russell.
3. If the drawn ticket does not have an envelope number or has an invalid number, the CAC will make one (1) attempt to contact the ticket holder at the phone number indicated on the ticket. The holder will be asked to select a number from the remaining envelopes and that card will be revealed. If unsuccessful in contacting the holder, the lowest remaining envelope number is selected by CAC.
4. The winning ticket holder will win 20% of the weekly ticket sales and a chance to draw for the current round's Catch the Ace jackpot.
- ~~5.~~ If the Ace of Spades is selected, the winner receives the amount in the Catch the Ace jackpot. *This will conclude the series of draws for this raffle.*
- ~~6.~~ If the Ace of Spades is not selected the card and envelope number are removed from the subsequent draws.

² If it is deemed necessary to move to a larger location, Russell Township will be notified of the location change. Alternatives to the Russell Legion location include the Russell Arena (Concession St in Russell), the Embrun Community Centre, Blais Street in Embrun, and the Russell Township Sports Dome (under construction).

7. The winning ticket holder will be notified by phone and advised when and where he/she can claim their prize. Photo identification will be required to claim any prize. All prizes will be paid by cheque, in Canadian funds, to the person named on the winning ticket.

5.1.1 Draw Rules – Week 48 Only

1. If, after 47 weeks the Ace of Spades has not been selected, the Progressive Jackpot will be awarded on the 48th week of the raffle.
2. The winning ticket holder will win 20% of the weekly ticket sales and a chance to draw for the current round's Catch the Ace jackpot.
3. If the Ace of Spades is not selected, another ticket will be drawn. This and all subsequent tickets drawn after the first ticket, will not win the weekly prize but the envelope number shown on the ticket will be eligible for the Progressive Jackpot.
4. If the drawn ticket does not have an envelope number or an invalid number, the CAC will make one (1) attempt to contact the ticket holder at the phone number indicated on the ticket. The holder will be asked to select a number from the remaining envelopes and that card will be revealed. If unsuccessful in contacting the holder, the lowest remaining envelope number is selected by CAC.
5. The ticket holder that reveals the Ace of Spades is declared the Jackpot Winner.
